Qualifications and Conditions

- 1. Not having deduction of 20 points or above of conduct scores.
- 2. Not having more than 2 SIIT student IDs.
- 3. No outstanding balance with SIIT.
- 4. Must resign from old student ID before the registration process for new student ID.
- 5. Admission will be considered from the scores the are used in the first admission to SIIT and the scores must be valid not more than 2 academic years (for the applicants who have submitted portfolio and scores in TCAS3 Round, they must submit other type of the scores for consideration instead).

- 2. Copies of citizen ID card or passport (foreign applicants) of the guardians and applicants

- 4. A copy of High School transcript.
